

Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes

Acting Chairperson Trustee Benes called the Public Safety Committee Meeting to order at 6:05 PM.

Monthly Reports: Chief Hare reviewed the June 2016 Monthly Reports. Other: Chief Hare discussed a new foundation that will establish a 501(c) (3) that will allow people to donate to the village or police department in case of a crisis situation, such as a tornado. A brief discussion was held.
