CenCom is the first and currently the only dispatch center to offer text service in Lake County. Placing a voice call to 911 is still the most efficient method to get access to police, fire and medical



services, but texting 911 can be

Round Lake Beach Tree Replacement Program

Round Lake Beach will look greener, as the annual Tree Replacement Program will begin this fall. The Village Board approved a contract with Brancato Landscaping to plant 260 trees within the Village's right-of-way, parkways,

and properties. The Tree Replacement Program includes 13 different types of trees to maintain diversity, which will help avoid future pest or disease from destroying a significant portion of the tree population.

Managing Stormwater on Your Property

Homeowners are challenged with how to manage storm water on their property.

Here are a few tips to address standing water problems:

Consider simple remedies like relocating your downspouts and sump pump discharge to reduce the volume of water flowing to the low spot. Be open

to Best Management Practices like rain barrels, rain gardens and permeable pavers. Rain gardens use specific plants and soils that absorb large amounts of rainwater
