## **From the Department of Public Works**

### **Summer and mosquitoes**

The Village's mosquito control program began in late May with inspections and treatment of breeding sites-retention ponds, drainage ditches, wetlands or low areas that tend to hold water, and inspections will continue through early September. Almost 100 acres will be treated by hand, backpack and helicopter within the Village this summer to reduce nuisance mosquito populations and prevent the spread of West Nile Virus. In addition this season, street side catch basins will be treated by technicians on bicycles in June and July to help reduce mosquito breeding in the underground water system.

Four adult mosquito control treatments will be performed during the season to kill adult mosquitoes "on the wing". Adult mosquito control is performed based on adult mosquito surveillance in the area and is not prescheduled. If you would like to be notified prior to spraying please contact the "Mosquito Hotline" at (800) 942-2555 and asked to be placed on the Prior Notification List for the Village of Round Lake Beach.

Homeowners are also encouraged to report stagnant water (3 days or more) on their property this summer to the same Mosquito Hotline.

### **Waste Management rate increase**

Per our contract with Waste Management, an increase of 5% for all refuse, recycling and landscape waste removal will be effective on July 1, 2010.

### **Meter inspection before moving**

Before an occupancy permit can be scheduled, a final water meter inspection has to be done by the Public Works department. This should be done three weeks prior to moving. If you have any questions please call Public Works at (847) 546-8752 from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm, Monday - Friday.

### **Electronics recycling**

The Village of Round Lake Beach will be hosting Electronic Recycling Collections on the third Thursday of every other month from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm at the Round Lake Beach Public Works facility located at 911 Lotus Drive. ## **Conserve water and save money**

The Village encourages you to reduce your water bills by conserving water. Fix any faucet, toilet or shower head leaks. Use the dishwasher and washing machine only with full loads. Take showers rather than baths and keep them short. Install low flow toilets and shower heads. If you have questions about your water bill, please call 847-546-2351 or stop by the Village Hall.
