State elections and advisory referendum on ballot

Election Day is Tuesday, November 2, 2010. Don't forget to mark your calendar. Do contact the Lake County Clerk's office for information on all the different options for voting this year. The Clerk's office has made it easy for everyone, including voting by mail. Call (847) 377-2400 or go to www.lakecountyil.gov/countyclerk for more information.

There are many important races on the ballot, which I encourage you to become informed about. The Governor's race, U.S.

Senators and Representatives, and State Senators and Representatives are on the ballot as is an advisory referendum calling for public safety pension reform.

In this economic downturn please know, as always, that your village is monitoring the economy and the effects on the daily operations. While we continue to offer services at a reasonable cost to our residents, an area that is of increasing concern to the village and other municipalities is the state mandated pension

contributions for public safety officers. In response, the Chicago Area Metropolitan Mayors Caucus has asked all cities and villages to submit a referendum to its citizens to seek input as to whether the governor and state legislature should enact meaningful pension reform relative to public safety workers, as they have recently done for other public employees.

The village greatly values the service of our officers and feels that it is our

responsibility to provide a fair and reasonable pension. There is a lot of information regarding this topic. So I encourage you to make an informed decision and do vote on November 2. Please note that there is additional information on our village website at www.villageofroundlakebeach.org.

From the Department of Public Works

No leaf or brush burning

Autumn is upon us once again. Please keep in mind that the Village of Round Lake Beach does not allow open burning, including, but not limited to, leaves, small branches, twigs, trees, paper, grass clippings, rubbish or any other type of vegetable matter at any place within the corporate limits of the village.

Yard waste disposal

You may dispose of leaves and other yard waste by putting them into the brown yard waste bags with a yard waste sticker on it or you may put them into 32-gallon cans marked yard waste with a yard waste sticker on it. Residents may put six bags or six 32 gallon cans out per week. If you already subscribe to the yard waste pick-up, you do not need a yard waste sticker. Maximum weight per bag or can is less than 50 pounds.

Branches must be bundled and tied with string or twine and have a yard waste sticker on them. Bundles should not exceed two feet in diameter or four feet in length and must weigh less than 50 pounds. Individual branches and limbs may be no thicker than 2 inches in diameter. No dirt, sod, or rock can be included with the yard waste.

Please do not put yard waste in plastic bags as they are not biodegradable and will not be picked up. Price for yard waste stickers is \$2.25 each. You may purchase the yard waste stickers at Ace Hardware (659 Railroad Avenue, Round Lake), Jewel Food Store (900 Rollins Road, Round Lake Beach) and Round Lake Beach Village Hall (1937 Municipal Way, Round Lake Beach).

From October 18-November 26, leaf pickup stickers will cost only \$1.10 each. These stickers can be purchased at the same locations as your regular yard waste stickers. The season for yard waste pick up will end on December 14.
