Round Lake Beach forms Census Committee

The Round Lake Beach Village Clerk, Margie Cleveland, announced the formation of a Complete Count Committee at the September 14 board meeting. Clerk Cleveland read the proclamation which highlighted that the Decennial Census will be taken in 2010. The proclamation explained that political representation to the US House of Representatives, state legislators and local governments are determined by this census. The census information is also used to obtain funding for essential services and programs for the village.

The Village of Round Lake Beach recognizes that each resident needs to be counted to insure a complete census for our community so the village has agreed to join in partnership with the U.S. Bureau of the Census. The primary role of the village is to form a "Complete Count Committee". This committee, lead by Clerk Margie Cleveland, will help in bridging the gaps between the Village of Round Lake Beach and the Census Bureau with outreach activities, getting information out about the Census to our residents and to help educate people about what the Census is used for and how all of the information collected is completely private.
