**Original Post:**

During the past 24 hours, the Lake County area has experienced significant heavy rain. In many areas throughout the County, including Round Lake Beach, flood waters have made many roads impassable, flooded basements, flooded yards and generally making transportation and living conditions a challenge for all of us.

Sanitary & storm sewers in many low laying areas are beyond capacity creating street and basement flooding. The following recommendations are offered when approaching flooded areas:

1. Do not attempt to drive through flood waters. You may not be able to tell the depth of water could damage your vehicle and become stranded.
2. Do not walk through flooded areas as water may contain high levels of bacteria. In addition, manhole covers and street drain covers may have come off during heavy rains and created hazardous conditions.
3. Do not enter flooded basements or other areas without knowing electrical power is off or disconnected. Contact ComEd at 1-800-334-7661 for questions.
4. **Contact** the Public Works Department at 847-546-8752 to report basement and/or street flooding. The Public Works office is open M-F from 7:00am – 3:30pm. After hours, you may contact the the Police Department non-emergency number 847-270-9111. Dial 911 for any life threatening emergency.
