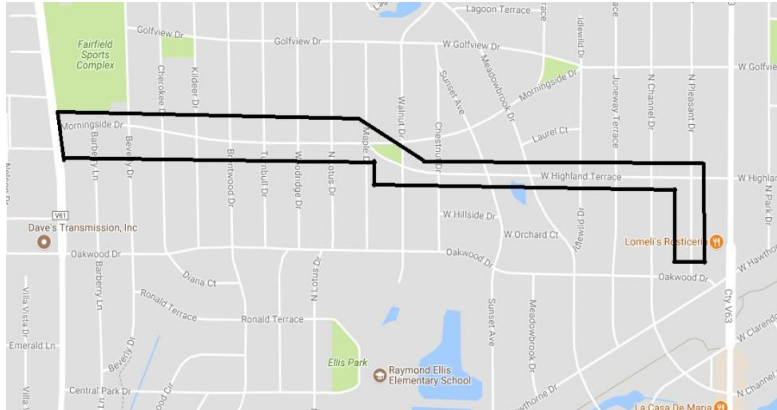

Dear Customer,

Nicor Gas will be completing a public improvement project on your street in Round Lake Beach. Our contractor, NPL, will be relocating the natural gas main on your street. As part of this work, we will also replace the natural gas service line to your home. After the new natural gas service line has been installed, Nicor Gas or NPL will contact you to schedule an appointment to connect the new service line to your home. Your natural gas will need to be shut off for approximately three hours during this stage of the project.
